Children on the Golf Course

The Creston Golf Club and Creston Junior Golf Club have adopted the following policies to help manage Junior Golf at the club.

1. All juniors will abide by the Junior Code of Conduct of the BC Golf Association.
2. Children under the age of 6 will not be allowed on the golf course at any time.
3. Children and grandchildren of active members of the Creston Golf Club will be allowed on the golf course at the discretion of the pro shop.
4. Child Playing Dues will be available to children 9 to 12 years of age. These children must complete the required programs as determined by the Junior Golf Club prior to being allowed on the golf course. Younger children may be accepted as members provided they are children or grandchildren of active members and are supervised by these members at all times.
5. Child members will be encouraged to participate in Junior Night Thursdays, and may be allowed to play at other off-peak period times as allowed by the pro shop. Parental supervision may be requested for some of the younger children. These children will not be permitted to play golf or be present at the facility before 1 pm on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays or during periods reserved for Men's and Ladies' Day.
6. Children accompanying non-member guests of the Creston Golf Club will be allowed on the golf course under the same restrictions as above. These children will be allowed to play golf provided they are members of other facilities and have been educated in the etiquette and behaviour associated with the game. Non-playing children will be allowed to accompany their parents at off-peak period times only.
